1. Wound Numbering

Added "Wound Number" field. Allows the user to change the number of the wound. Defaults to 1 on the first wound and defaults to next open number for a patient with multiple wounds.

2. Wound Marking

Added "Wound Mark" field. Defaults to "Open". Allows the user to change to closed, discharged or discharged to hospital.

- Open** = for wounds with a length, width and/or depth
- Closed** = for wounds that have zero for length, width and depth
- Discharged** = wound has a measurement and is discharged from care
- Discharged to Hospital** = wound has a measurement and is discharged from care to Hospital

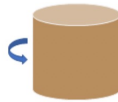

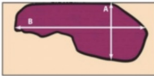

What is a circumferential wound?

A wound that goes around the outside edge of a round or curved body part.



Measure the length "head-to-toe" at the longest point (A). Measure the width around the outside of the round or curved body part at the widest point (B) that is perpendicular to the length forming a '+'.

It is recommended to measure circumferential wounds using a flexible measurement device such as a tape measure.

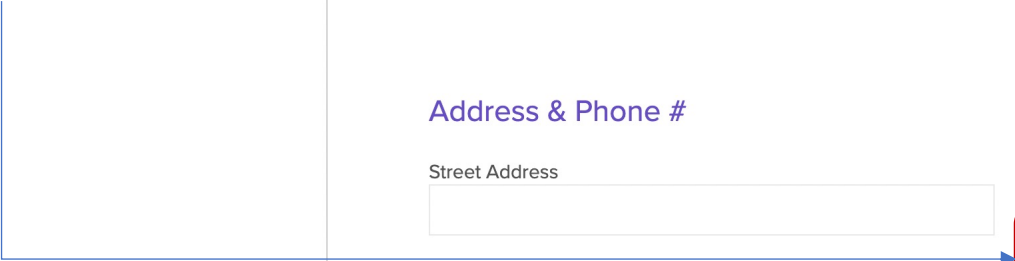

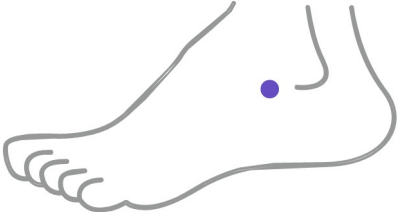

6. Copy Assessment and Treatment – Triage Users Only

When clicking the “+” the “Do you want to copy the Previous Assessment/Treatment” question is presented.

If “Yes” is selected, the previous assessment and treatment will be copied and saved as a new assessment / treatment on the current day. **This feature is a big time-saver** especially if not much will change from one assessment / treatment to the next.

If “No, Start from Scratch” is selected, the user can start a new assessment/treatment from the beginning.
